Taylorsville Farmers Market Regulations

1. The Taylorsville Farmers Market will operate on **Saturday mornings from 8 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** and will be held in the **parking lot near the junction of Highways 44 and 55 in Downtown Taylorsville. It is located at 73 E. Main Street.**
2. If you are reselling someone else's product, the product must be labeled with the farm origin and you must produce a minimum of 50% of the products you are selling.
3. Before participating, all vendors must complete and sign the application and pay the \$30 membership fee plus the Vegetable \$10. Checks should be made to **"Taylorsville Farmers Market Inc."** Local active FFA and 4-H members will pay no fee, but need to fill out an application. Submission of an application does not guarantee acceptance into the market. The market committee tries to keep a balanced market as to types of vendors and preference is given to returning vendors.
4. Any vendors not coming to the market on a weekend must notify Sandi no later than 5PM on Friday. If you are a part-time vendor, you must call or text Sandi Deutsch (376-3888) by Thursday before the market to let them know when you plan to attend and what products you will be selling at the market that week.
5. It is recommended that vendors selling processed products purchase private product liability insurance.
6. Local crafts are allowed after being reviewed and certified by the market committee.
7. Spaces on set-up day are assigned 12' x12' spaces. We only have room for each vendor to occupy one space. Only normal sized vehicles will be allowed to park at the Farmers Market.
8. The market committee may set a range of prices for produce items. Vendors are expected to refrain from engaging in the underselling of other vendors. Your prices should be posted and easily visible at all times.
9. The market committee has the right to amend any and all rules without previous notice.
10. All participants must be a member of the KY Proud Program. Application is attached. Please make a copy of your KY Proud certificate or completed application and submit with your Farmers Market application. Please mail in your KY Proud application on your own. If you are already a member of the KY Proud Program, please submit a copy of your KY Proud Certificate with your application.
11. If you are offering samples of processed or value added products only (no raw/unprocessed), you must hold a current KDA Sampling Certificate for Cooked or Processed. If you need to apply, complete the sampling application and return it to KY Department of Agriculture (address is on application). If you are offering samples of raw or unprocessed foods, you must you must hold a current KDA Sampling Certificate for All Samples. If you need to apply, complete the sampling application and attend a PBPT training session on handling raw products. Contact Bryce Roberts at the Spencer Co. Extension Service (477-2217) for training information. **Please submit a copy of your certificates for sampling processed foods and/or Produce Best Practices Training Program (PBPT).** You should receive these from the KY Department of Agriculture.
12. All permits and licenses that are required for the products you are selling must be posted at all times at the market.
